7. Exhibits must be completed by 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24, with the exception of fresh materials which can be added Thursday, June 25th from 9:00-10:00 a.m., only. There will be no exceptions.
8. Division 544 is open to all organized youth groups, i.e.: Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Junior Grange, etc.

1. Panel displays are to be educational in nature, and should illustrate a single idea/theme. High scoring exhibits will be artistically arranged, colorful and attractive, as well as easy to read at a distance. Each panel display will be hung in the center aisle of appropriate barn.
2. These divisions are limited to one entry by a club, chapter or organization in each species.
3. Panels are to be decorated on both sides. Lighting or moving parts are to be battery-operated only.
4. Panels must be designed and constructed by organization members. Adults may supervise only.
5. Panels are to be 4' by 8' plywood sheet (width-ways). Two drilled hanging holes are needed: one each to be placed 4" from top of panel and 12" from side (see example).
6. Exhibits must be delivered to Johnson Hall on Thursday, June 18th. Panels will be hung by Fair staff.
7. Each panel to be labeled with chapter/club name.
8. Classes will be individually judged for ribbons only – 1st through 5th place. Top two winners in each class then compete for overall Best of Show – 1st through 5th place.

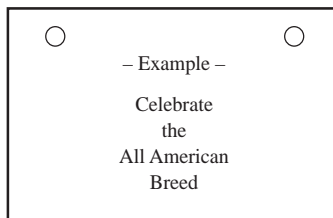

All entries must have been made, collected, prepared by the exhibitor in accordance with the requirements or recommendation of that project. Entries that require packaging and labeling, such as food preservation and entomology, must be done in accordance with directions in project manuals/outlines. Check carefully the recommendations for kind/size or container and method of labeling. Only standard containers, specifically designed for the purpose, will be accepted. All items will be judged at the time they are received, except foods and food preservation. Exhibitors are encouraged to be present at the time of judging.

Danish System of Judging

The Danish System of Judging is based upon established standards of quality for each type of project. Each exhibit is judged accordingly to how well it meets that standard rather than how it compares with other exhibits. In all Junior Departments using the Danish System, the following guidelines shall be used by judges:

1st Group	Superior.....92-100%	blue
2nd Group	Good.....84-91%	red
3rd Group	Average, acceptable70-83%	white
4th Group	Poor, undesirable.....69% or less	-
