Miss Placer County & Miss Teen Placer County Scholarship Pageant Contract 2010

As a condition of my admission to compete in the Miss /Teen Placer County Pageant, I certify and agree to the following:

1. I am a current resident of Placer County and am or will be between the ages of 15 and 27 as of the June 1st 2010 date.
2. I am currently unmarried and have never been married. I agree that if I win a title in this pageant (included in the definition of "title" are Miss /Teen Placer County, I will not marry during the time I hold my title.
3. Born a Female. I am not pregnant at this time. I agree that if I win a title in this pageant, I will not become pregnant during the time I hold my title.
4. I have never been convicted of a crime. I have neither admitted nor had a petition sustained against me as a minor. I agree that if I win a title in this pageant, I will not commit a crime.
5. I will participate in all events leading up to the final selection of Miss/ Teen Placer County, I understand that failure to attend any of these designated events will count be noted.
6. I will attend all rehearsals required of me as a contestant. I understand that if I am absent for an unexcused reason from a rehearsal, I will be disqualified. An excused absence is one cleared, in advance if possible, by the Director.
7. If I am crowned "Miss /Teen Placer County 2010 I will make myself available for events promoting the community until such time as I give up my reign the following year, or am crowned another title. I understand that my responsibilities include, but are not limited to making public appearances, assisting with fundraisers, visiting local civic group events, attending parades, fairs, holiday celebrations, other pageants, ribbon cuttings, and those events deemed appropriate by the Director. I understand that reasonable notice will be given in advance of events I should attend.
8. I agree to allow the "Miss /Teen Placer County Pageant, and anybody duly licensed by them to televise, photograph, broadcast, and/or take involving pictures of me singly or in a group. I agree that these pictures are the sole property of the Kennedy Pageant Productions, Area Producer of Official preliminaries to a Miss California and a Miss California Teen Pageants and I consent to their use for promotional purposes.
9. I agree that a contestant who is determined to have a negative attitude towards the Director, Assistant Director, other pageant officials, or contestants, will be disqualified.
10. I must not be employed by any division or company owned Patty Kennedy or Kennedy Pageant Productions or Placer County Fair.
11. I agree not to enter any other pageant competition unless it is in furtherance of my title as Miss California and other pageants as expected and pre-approved by my Director, until I pass my title to the next title holder at the end of my reign.
12. I understand that if I am part of the Miss/ Teen Placer County and any of these requirements are not met, or if I fail to fulfill them during my reign without such failure being excused in advance by the Director, I will be required to forfeit my title and the prizes, which accompany it including but not limited to crown, sash, trophy, scholarships, cash, and gifts. I understand that I will not be entitled to any refunds. I understand that in the case of my forfeiture of title, my title, at the discretion of the Director or Kennedy Pageant Productions, or Placer County Fair may be passed on to the next scoring contestant.

I understand that at the Directors discretion, contestants not crowned as “Miss/ Teen Placer County still may be given the opportunity to attend and compete at the “A Miss California/Teen ” pageant of Director’s choice under separate titles including “Miss Sacramento Cities/Teen ” pageant title. If such opportunities are afforded, all expenses will be the responsibility of the contestant.

14. I currently hold no other Queen titles in Placer County that would interfere if I shall win the Miss/Teen Placer County Title and by doing so would give up any other title.

I voluntarily agree to the terms and conditions outlined above as applied to my involvement in the Miss/Teen Placer County Scholarship Pageant and events associated with it.
